YOUR EXCELLENCY,

I have the honour to refer to your letter of September 12th, 1956 regard-  
ing an extension of the *modus vivendi* which governs trade between Canada  
and Venezuela.

The Canadian Government feels that this *modus vivendi* has been instru-  
mental in strengthening trade relations between Canada and Venezuela.  
Accordingly, I have the honour to propose that it be extended for a further  
period of one year, from October 11, 1956.

Should Your Excellency's Government concur in this proposal, may I  
suggest that this Note, together with Your Excellency's reply, shall be con-  
sidered as constituting an Agreement between the Government of Canada and  
the Government of Venezuela to renew the terms of the *modus vivendi* of  
October 11, 1950\*, for a further period of one year.

I take this opportunity of presenting to Your Excellency the assurance of  
my highest consideration.
