Mr. Regan observed that seminars represent a "networking" of the Sydney and Melbourne posts, External Affairs trade personnel and industry sector officials in the Department of Regional Industrial Expansion and the Department of Communications.

Some of the companies participating were major exhibitors at Telecom 83, the world exposition on telecommunications held in Geneva, October 26-November 1, 1983. "Their export managers are aware that developing markets is a continuing process requiring, among other things, participation in trade fairs, being members of outgoing missions and hosts of incoming missions from foreign buyers," the Minister said.
