

such objects alone would perhaps not present a very agreeable appearance; but by making a judicious arrangement of them, the whole might be made most attractive.

Your Committee have received minute information in regard to the lighting, heating and general internal management of a Museum, the particulars of which would be too voluminous to be contained within this report, but they are filed away and in the hands of the Secretary.

Your Committee is of opinion that the upper portion of the Public Library building will answer the purposes and furnish space enough for the museum for years to come.
