RULES AT A MEETING OF BUSINESS.

RULE 1. After the Company is called to order, each member shall be seated and uncovered.

RULE 2. Any member wishing to speak must rise in his place, and address the Chair.

RULE 3. A motion made and seconded, the Chairman shall decide whether it is in order, he shall repeat the motion, and ask if any member has anything to offer.

RULE 4. No member can speak more than twice upon any one question without permission of the Chair.

RULE 5. After a debate the Chairman shall repeat the motion, before the question is taken, and say are you ready for the question.
