

BYE LAWS.

ARTICLE I.—ELECTION OF OFFICERS.

The election of the Council of the Association, and of all Officers chosen or appointed by the Council, shall be by ballot, upon nomination duly made and seconded; and no vote shall count for any person not so nominated.

ARTICLE II.—ANNUAL MEETING.

At least fourteen days' notice of the place appointed by the Council, for the annual meeting of the Association, shall be given by the Secretary by advertisement in the *Royal Gazette*.

ARTICLE III.—MEETINGS OF COUNCIL.

1. The regular quarterly meetings of the Council shall be held on the first Thursday in May, August, November, and February, at such time and place as the President may direct.
2. Special meetings of the Council may be called at any time by the President, and shall be called by him on the written request of any two members of the Council.
3. Notice of the time and place of every quarterly and special meeting of the Council, shall be issued by the Secretary to each member, at least ten days before the day appointed for the meeting.
4. Meetings of the Council may be adjourned from day to day, as may be found necessary.
5. If at any quarterly or special meeting of the Council, a quorum be not present, three members of the Council (an Officer of the Association being one), shall have power, after waiting half an hour, to adjourn the meeting to another time; and it shall not be necessary to issue notices for such adjourned meeting.

ARTICLE IV.—COMPETITIONS.

1. The annual meeting, to compete for the Prizes offered by the Association, shall be held at such time and place, during the first week in September in each year, as the Council may appoint.
2. Notice of the time and place of the Annual Competition shall be given by the Secretary, by advertisement in the *Royal Gazette*, at least one month before the first of the days appointed for the meeting.

ARTICLE V.

1. An Umpire shall be appointed, whose points shall be taken.
2. An Officer shall be appointed to take command of the match, and to maintain order.
3. There shall be a distance of 600 yards.
4. The size of the target shall be down in the Appendix.

5. The shooter shall be allowed to shoot the remaining target unless off the shot.
6. No magnifying glass shall be allowed at a target, or leather or other material to pull thereof, or to forfeit any prize again during the match.
7. In shooting, the shooter shall be less than six paces from the target.
8. Competitor shall be before, during, or after the match.
9. TIES. When two or more competitors tie, the ties shall be decided by a distance in the competition, counting the shots, counting the hits.
3. If still a tie, the match shall be singly.
4. If still a tie, the match shall be in the competition only:—1. By the shooter from the last shot.
