

PREPARES FOR ARCTIC DASH

MacMillan's Ship Under Construction in Maine—Baffin Land is the Objective.

East Boothbay, Me., Feb. 7.—Work is almost completed on the hull of the Bowdoin, in which Dr. Donald B. MacMillan, explorer, will make his next dash into the Arctic regions. The launching of the schooner will take place in the early spring, and the vessel will be in shape to depart from this port by May 1.

Dr. MacMillan is perfecting plans for an expedition to begin next summer, which will include an attempt to circumnavigate Baffin Land, and penetrate its western coast, 1,000 miles in length, said to be the longest stretch of unknown coastline in the world. He is a frequent visitor here and keeps careful watch over the construction of his ship. The Bowdoin, which is being built on the sturdy lines needed in an expedition vessel to withstand the ice-grind, is 70 feet in length, over all, 20 feet wide and equipped with 45 horsepower oil-burning engines. Three inch oak-plank material is being used for the hull.

Before his departure for the far north, Dr. MacMillan will make an exhibition cruise along the coast during May and June. About July 1, with a party of six men, the explorer will sail from Boston for the polar regions.

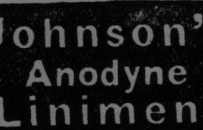
Under favorable weather conditions the Bowdoin should reach Foul Bay, Hecla Strait early in September. There the ship will be frozen in.

Leaving their ship under a lone guard, the party will push forward on a 900-mile trip on sleds drawn by dogs. Five Eskimo dog-drivers will accompany the MacMillan outfit across the rugged, ice-bound country which abounds in perils. Establishing a camp 700 miles south of Etah, in the northwestern part of Greenland, is one of the main objectives. Within the last twelve years, Dr. MacMillan has made six trips into the land

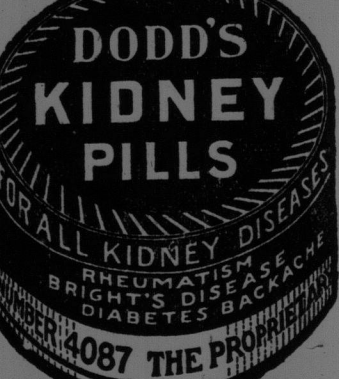

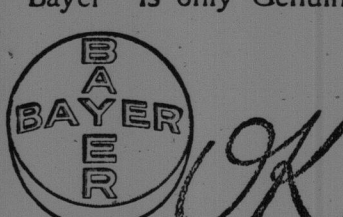

WANT AMONG NOVA SCOTIA FISHER FOLK

Halifax, N. S., Feb. 7.—"Well, I dunno anything about Reverend Miller taking a collection for people at Herring Cove, but I heard Father MacKinnon was collecting money for some Bear Cove Herring Cove leaning over the counter of Ole Johnston's store on Water Street and looking pointedly at the proprietor who formerly lived in Bear Cove. Five amount of destitution in two Nova Scotia fishing villages. The opinion of authorities with respect to the degree of distress existing along the coast of the Province varies, but the general consensus of opinion appears to be that the situation in the homes of fishermen who did not lay by their earnings for the proverbial rainy day, now at hand, is anything but happy. This is more especially true in the districts neighboring the towns and industrial centres where the people deserted their nets for the more remunerative pick and shovel in the recent days of the manufacturing boom. Thrown out of their jobs by "shut-downs" and "lay-offs" they are now returning to a lean harvest of the deep, and churches are collecting money to supply flour and fuel to those who are really suffering. Fortunately these are comparatively few in number.

"I should say about ten per cent. of the population of the fishing villages of Nova Scotia is actually in want of the necessities of life," said Arthur Boulter of the National Fish Company. The worst phase of the whole situation is that the time of stress is apparently still in the offing. The prices of fishing supplies have not dropped in equality with the price of fish, and those who buy their fishing gear now will have to pinch themselves with small prospect of recovering on the catch in the spring unless it is a particularly large one.

The outlook for the fishermen of Nova Scotia generally is bad, and there are dangerous days ahead," said R. H. Williams of the Roberts Simpson Company to the Canadian Press. "However, I don't think there is actually much want among them yet."

Last year fishermen who stayed with their nets did fairly well on the average as these should be able to weather hard times until the season opens in April or May, but the re-flow of population to the villages from the cities where days are difficult, has created a situation not without its bad aspects.
