On motion of Rep. Laing, seconded by Rep. Bissell, it was resolved that a vote of thanks be and the same is hereby tendered to the Officers and Brethren of Union Lodge, No. 16, for the use of their Lodge Room, and for the very great kindness and courtesy manifested and extended by them to the Grand Lodge, during its present Session.

The business of this Session of the Grand Lodge having been brought to a close, the same adjourned, to meet at the City of London, on the first Wednesday in the month of August, 1857.
