The Sub-Committee of Charity in reporting to the Committee of Management beg to submit the following statement:—

The ordinary expenditure for the year past has amounted to \$450.88 which with a Christmas dinner sent to twenty-seven English families costing the sum of \$69.42 makes a total of \$519.79. Of the amount paid Finlay Asylum this year \$70.80, the sum of \$35.70 was for the previous year making the real expenditure for this year \$414.67 being \$31.26 less than last year.
