Settled in Ottawa. in 1841. M., 1847, Margaret, dau. of the late Col. Powell, of H. M. 101st Regt. Was for some years engaged in the forwarding business, and then became an Official Assignee under the Insolvent Act. of the Ottawa Electric Co., and been Manager of the Ottawa Gas Works since 1866. Was a member of the City Council, Cttawa, for two years, and Chairman for years of the Board of Water Commrs. Was Grand Master of the Orangemen, Co. of Carleton, for eight years. Was Chair. man of the Committee of the Whole in the Senate, in 1892, on the Bill to Codify the Criminal Laws of Canada. Called to the Senate, 3 Feb., 1885. Cochrane, Hon. Matthew Henry (Wellington).
