VI. And for the purpose of determining any right of Who shall be property, possession or occupation in or to any lands belonging or appropriated to any tribe or body of Indians in Lower Canada, be it declared and enacted: That the 5 following classes of persons are and shall be considered as Indians belonging to the Tribe or body of Indians interested in such lands:

1st. All persons of Indian blood, reputed to belong to the particular body or Tribe of Indians interested in such 10 lands, and their descendants.

2ndly. All persons intermarried with any such Indians and residing amongst them, and the descendants of all such persons.

3rdly. All persons residing amongst such Indians, 15 whose parents on either side were or are Indians of such body or tribe, or entitled to be considered as such: and

4thly. All persons adopted in infancy by any such Indians, and residing in the village or upon the lands of such Tribe or body of Indians, and their descendants.

20 VII. And be it enacted, That the Interpretation Act Interpretation shall apply to this Act.
