Liquor Licence Act, 1861, and this Act how to be construed. III. The said "Liquor Licence Act, 1861," shall so far as it does not conflict with Sections One and Two of this Act, be deemed and taken to be part of this Act and construed accordingly.

Nanaimo Town defined. IV. For the Purposes of this Act Nanaimo Town shall be the Tract of Land included within a Circle, the Radius of which shall extend One Mile from the Site of the Old Bastion of the Hudson Bay Company.

Short Title. V. This Act may be cited for all Purposes as "The Liquor Licence Act, 1866."
