An Act respecting Inventions, Trade Marks and Designs.

WHEREAS it is expedient to make new provisions relating to the granting of Letters Patent for Inventions and the registering of Trade Marks and Designs: Therefore, her Majesty, by and with the 5 advice and consent of the Legisative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

ORGANIZATION OF PATENT OFFICE.

- 1. There shall be established at the Seat of Government an office, to Patent Office: be called "The Patent Office."
- 2. The Governor may appoint, by Commission under the Great Seal, Commissioner 10 a "Commissioner of Patents," to whom the management of the Patent Office shall be confided, and also a Secretary to the Patent Office.

 - 3. The Patent Office shall be attached to the Bureau of Agriculture, Attached to and unless otherwise provided, the Minister of Agriculture shall be the Bureau of Agriculture. Commissioner of Patents.

 - 4. The said Commissioner shall, before he enters upon the duties of Oath of office. his office, make oath or affirmation truly and faithfully to execute the trust committed to him.
- 5. The said Commissioner shall cause a seal to be made for the pur-seal of office.

- 6. There shall be kept in the said office a book or books, wherein shall Certain books be entered and recorded in chronological order, all Letters Patent of to be kept in Invention granted under this Act, the deposit or filing of Applications, Office.

Printed or manuscript copies or extracts, certified by the Com-Certified missioner, of Letters Patent, Specifications, Disclaimers, memoranda of copies of ceralterations, and all other documents recorded and filed in the Patent ments to be Office, before or after the passing of this Act, shall be received in evi-evidence.
