

removal of the impediment, whereby he, she or they are disabled or hindered to exhibit such memorial, shall be a sufficient registry within the meaning of this Act, any thing herein-contained to the contrary thereof in any wise notwithstanding.

XIII. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that nothing in this Act contained shall be held or construed in any manner or way to affect or in any wise alter the laws heretofore in force in this Province with respect to the liability of *Tuteurs*, *Curateurs*, or others entrusted with the administration of property belonging or appertaining to Minors, Absentees, insane persons, or persons by law incapable of administering their own affairs, nor to innovate upon, nor in any manner or way to alter or diminish the liability to which the real and immoveable property of persons charged with any public trust or duty, might by the existing laws of the Province be affected, nor to alter in any way the laws of this Province relating to the judgments of any of the Courts of King's Bench in this Province, nor with respect to marriage contracts, nor with respect to *partages* among heirs or any other family partition, or division of property of the like nature.

XIV. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that all and every penalty incurred under this Act, shall and may be sued for and recovered in any of His Majesty's Courts of Record in this Province by plaint or information upon oath of one or more credible witness or witnesses, and the said penalty or penalties shall be paid to his Majesty, his heirs and successors for the public uses of this Province, and the support of the government thereof, and the due application of the same shall be accouted for to His Majesty, His Heirs and Successors, through the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury for the time being in such a manner and form as His Majesty, His Heirs and Successors shall direct.
