In acknowledging the receipt of your letter of the 5th instant-B.L.298-G.R.707- in connection with the right of way through the S.W.1/4 of Section 12, Tp. 20, Rge. 15, W-2-M, I have to advise that the Department has been in communication with Mr. J.R.Miller, the purchaser of this quarter section, as to whether he had received from your company the payment in full covering the right of way. We have now heard from Mr. Miller and I am pleased to acquaint you of the fact that he reports that he has received payment covering the right of way and that he will make payment of the balance due the Department. As this money has been received the Grant to your company covering the right of way will be prepared at an early date and forwarded to the Registrar of Titles Regina, Sask.
