With reference to the account from Dr F.C. Woodworth, which you forwarded with your letter of the 15th instant, for attendance rendered to Indians of King's County during June quarter last, I beg to remind you that Dr Jacques is paid a salary for attending the Indians of that County. There appears to have been no reason why the Indians treated by Dr Woodworth could not have gone to the regular medical officer Dr Jacques. Under the circumstances the Department objects to paying Dr Woodworth's account. We should look to the Indians whom he attended for payment.
