Sir,

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 18th instant, and in reply I beg to say that a book on hygiene will be sent you from the Department.

This Department has not on hand a map of Algoma, but application will be made to the Department of Lands and Forests, Toronto, for a map, if published. It will then have to be granted and you will see that sometime must elapse before this can be got for you.

The Agent will be authorized to purchase the plates, cup, tumbler, plates, sugar bowl and cream jug, the teaspoons and table spoons, but the Department does not furnish bedding or towels. These will have to be supplied by yourself and will, of course, remain your own property.
