Sir,-

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 29th ultimo, No. 673-23, inclosing a copy of a letter from Provincial Constable Wood having reference to Indians being supplied with liquor from wholesale houses, and suggesting that the Indian Act be amended so as to compel the Indian when giving the order to sign the word "Indian" after his name.

In reply I have to state that it is considered that it would be difficult to obtain legislation of the kind referred to.
