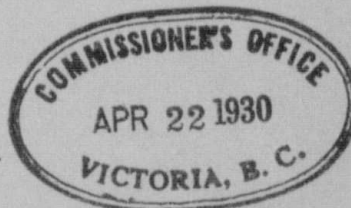
I have to advise that the subject matter of your letter dated 25th ult. relating to nineteen small parcels of land on the upper reaches of the Nass River required as additional Indian reserves has been given careful consideration.

If there is a bona fide need for these extra areas it is incomprehensible that the Indians cannot define the locations immediately. However, it has been decided to grant an extension of time for the location and survey of these parcels until December 31st, 1930, and it is expected that the matter will be completed by the expiration of the date mentioned.
