THE HOLY CATHOLIC CHURCH

The Church was prepared by Jesus Christ as a Body in which all Christians should be united to Him, and through which He would continue His work in the world. As in the case of Adam, the body of the Church was first formed by our Lord and included the Apostles, the Seventy, and the Disciples. Then, after careful training, the commission was given "as my Father hath sent me even so send I you," (Jno. xx. 21.) Then the ranks of Apostles were filled up, (Acts 1. 26.) Then, life was breathed into the Body by the Holy Ghost on Pentecost (Acts 11.) Then the Holy Ghost was given to new converts in Confirmation (Act v111.) Then, the Church, thus filled with life, spread gradually to different parts of the world, mainly through the missionary work of St. Paul. Still, notice that it is one undivided
