CAP. LXVII.

An Act to enable Thomas Edouard BelleIsle to undergo an examination to practise Medicine, Surgery and Midwiferv.

[Assented to 12th May, 1863.]

N7 HEREAS Thomas Edouard BelleIsle has proved that Preamble. he had studied medicine for two years in Lower Canada, at the end of which time he was compelled to leave Case of T. E. the country and take up his residence in the United States of America, where he continued to study medicine for three years, at the end of which time he underwent an examination before the medical faculty of the University of Burlington, in the State of Vermont, one of the United States of America; and that he had obtained a diploma from the said University authorizing him to practise medicine, surgery, and midwifery, and did practise the same for several years in the said United States of America; and whereas the said Thomas Edouard BelleIsle, having returned to Canada, is desirous of obtaining authority to practise medicine, surgery and midwifery: Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

1. It shall be lawful for the said Thomas Edouard Belle Isle He may be to present himself before the Board of Examiners of the Coleannine and lege of Physicians and Surgeons of Lower Canada, without found qualifollowing any new course of study; and if the said Thomas fied. Edouard Bellelsle is found by the said examiners to be properly qualified, he shall be entitled to obtain a license to practise medicine, surgery and midwifery, according to the By-Laws and Regulations of the said College.

2. This Act shall be deemed a Public Act.

CAP. LXVIII.

An Act to enable Elijah Rowell and Thomas Merrill Prime to be admitted to practise Medicine, Surgery and Midwifery.

[Assented to 12th May, 1863.]

WHEREAS Elijah Rowell, of Frelighsburg, in the County Preamble. of Missisquoi, and Thomas Merrill Prime, of the Township of Brome, in the County of Brome, by their petition, have Case of E.
