| The First Banks. <br> Few things play a more important part in our lives to-day than the system of banking. <br> The word bank originally meant a tradesman's stall, and the first bank in anything like the modern sense existed about 2,700 years ago. We learn about this bank from clay tablets discovered near Babylon. Apparently the first firm of bankers was in Babylon about 600 or 700 B.C. <br> The early Chinese were in the habit of issuing paper money-indeed, they got into difficulties by issuing too about A.D. 1,000. <br> But banking as we understand it today did not begin untll the twelfth century, when the Bank of Ventce was established. This was followed by the Bank of Barcelona, in Spain, and the Bank of Stockholm, in Sweden. The latter was the first bank in Europe to issue paper money. This was in 1668. Other early banks were the Bank of St. George, at Genoa, the Bank of Hamburg, and the Bank of Amsterdam. |
