WINE GROWERS START WAR ON BOGUS WINE. CHEMICALLY PREPARED STUPEFIED IN LONDON THEATRE. MARSILLIES, May 15.—An extraordinary demonstration was held today in the little town of Capestang, near Brest, where 15,000 vine growers gathered for the surrounding districts to hold a monster meeting, with the object of protesting against the fraudulent imitation of claret, which, it is said, is ruining the wine trade of the south of France.

The adjournment is until May 21st, when the Supreme Court sits here, and was at the request of the Crown prosecutor Turgeon.

BERLIN, May 14.—Fred Duncan, the brother of Isadora Duncan, the American dancer, is causing a sensation in Berlin by a crusade in favor of the "simple life." He wears little and simple clothes, and his wife, who is said to be a French woman, has followed him. They have descended, they eat only nuts and fruit.
