

I am instructed by the Gov-ernment that it is their intention to submit to the Legislature at its next session a Bill to limit the class of vessels entitled to Bounty from the Government inder the present Shipbuilding Bounty Law. Hereafter Bounty will be payable on vessels not exceeding 120 tons gross measurement. Vessels exceeding 120 tons gross will not qualify for any Bounty whatever. It is intended that the Regulations shall apply to all vessels of which the keel has been laid at the date of this notice; but all vessels, the keels of which are not now laid, shall come within the scope of the proposed new Regulations, and shall not be entitled to Bounty when the ves-sels exceed 120 tons gross meas-
