CAMP LIFE AT "RE-A-WAH" IDEAL FOR LONDON GIRLS

"The Nomad" Is Charmed With the W. C. T. U. Summer Camp Near Springbank—Open Air Life on the Hilltops—An Ideal Camp

"Re-a-wah! Re-a-wah! Rah, rah, rah!" Could you get up bright and early some morning and be in the vicinity of the reservoir hill at Springbank, about 7 o'clock, or—which is perhaps more likely—if you chanced to be in that particular region about 7 in the evening, your ears might quite probably be astonished with the above cry, ringing down through the stillness of the hillside, and echoing through the rustling leaves—"Re-a-wah! Re-a-wah!" Then suddenly you would recollect that you were not far from the Young Women's Christian Temperance Union summer camp, which is perched well up on the brow of the big hill.

For here it is that the girls who are fortunate enough to enjoy the privileges of the camp, spend their nights, and their Saturday afternoons, and their Sabbath, returning to and from the city morning and night.

Rest-A-While.

"Re-a-wah"—the name in itself is

suggestive of quiet and stillness and, at times, and sleeping out of doors in the open, just everything that ideal camp life embodies. The girls chose it themselves, so we were told when visiting the camp the other day, and it is not a really, truly Indian name as you might think, but simply a condensed form of what the camp means to the girls—"rest-a-while."

Upon a hot day it seems rather a stiff climb up the hillside before "Re-a-wah" is reached, but when one sights the first snowy tent, the pennants of "Welcome," and the gay lanterns which afford lighting after dusk, one feels amply repaid. Better still is the warm greeting accorded the visitor, and as we sat there looking away out over the smiling slopes beyond the river, upon wooded hills in the distance, and upon green farm fields, filled our lungs with the pure air of the hill-top, and hearkened to the note of the birds in the branches far overhead, we felt that here indeed was medicine and healing for soul, mind, and body. Whoever first conceived the idea of the summer camp, where direct city girls might spend their nights and week-ends, must surely have had inspiration from above.

The camp consists of one large tent, loaned by the board of education, several of smaller size, and a shack for cooking. The large tent is divided into two convenient sections. That to the right is occupied by a row of cots, where the girls sleep, practically in the open air. The other half is used as a dining-hall; a long table runs down the centre, with benches on either side.

"See, we even have a buffet," said the smiling W. C. T. U. lady who was showing us around the camp. "It is of original design, and we are very proud of it." One felt that they might well be, as one viewed the piece of furniture, to wit, an oblong box set on end, and furnished with shelves and a hinged door.

ARMY WORM REMEDY

How One Woman in Pittsburgh Got Rid of the Pest.

A correspondent writes, calling attention to the fact that a method of getting rid of army worms has been discovered in Pittsburgh, and suggests that the same method be employed in Ontario.

The remedy in question consists of lead arsenate, water and a small quantity of lye. Its effectiveness was discovered by the wife of Prof. G. W. Case, superintendent of grounds and buildings at the University of Pittsburgh. The trees and shrubs on the grounds had been attacked by the pest, and Prof. Case had tried everything he could think of to get rid of them. One evening he was discussing the matter with his wife, who is an experienced horticulturalist, and she asked: "Have you tried lead arsenate?"

The professor had not, and his wife proceeded to tell him just how to use it. Her directions were: Take two pounds of the arsenate, make it into a paste with two quarts of water. Dissolve the paste in a barrel of water and add a small quantity of lye.

The recipe was tried and found to be entirely successful.
