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STEAMER ARABIA NOW AT PORTLAND Was Captured by Vladivostok Cruisers and Afterwards Released.

Astoria, Ore., Sept. 29--The Oriental liner Arabia of the Portland-Asiatic line arrived here today from the Eastern port, twenty-four hours late as a result of being captured by a Russian vessel, Capt. Bahle's vessel was captured by the Russian Vladivostok squadron 100 miles north of Yokohama at the time when the cruisers Gromobol, Kossia and Hurik, under Admiral Jensen made his famous raid on the Japanese coast. The cruisers Gromobol brought the Arabia to a stop and three officers and forty-two men boarded her. The Arabia was taken to Vladivostok where several hundred men were taken from her hold. The Russians then were washed ashore along the coast and were being rotated when the liner was finally released.

ON THE WATCH. Russian Gunboat Reported Stationed at Unalak Pass. Bellingham, Sept. 29--A member of the crew of the Pacific Packing & Navigation Co. steamer, which just arrived in port from Alaska reports sighting a Russian gunboat. A heavy storm prevented the Russian gunboat from leaving the Unalak Pass. The gunboat was reported to be in the Unalak Pass, a narrow strait between the coast of Alaska and the island of Unalak Pass.

CHIEF JUSTICE OF PHILIPPINES. Manila, Sept. 29--Cayetano Arellano, chief justice of the Philippine islands, who was received in private audience by Pope Pius, left for the Philippines to-day. He will travel by the United States.
