AN IMPROBABLE POINT.

The H.A.A. Billiard Room-Licensed or no License.

From the Montreal Gazette, Dec. 10. The case of the revenue department against the Montreal Amateur Athletic association for keeping billiard tables with out a license was heard before Police Magistrate Demoyers yesterday morning.

The only witness examined was Horace S. Tibbs, secretary of the association. He deposed that the billiard tables were only kept for the amusement of the members of the association, and that the rates charged were merely to cover the expenses of the billiard room.

There was no intention on the part of the association to derive a revenue from the tables. Last year had fallen short of the expenses in connection with the billiard room, and although the charges are very low, it is not possible to come in for the expense of the billiard room, and although the charges are very low, it is not possible to come in for the expense of the billiard room.

R. D. McGibbon, who represented the association, contended that the evidence went to show that no profit had been derived from the billiard tables, and he deposed that the association could not be compelled to pay a license under the clause of the liquor license act compelling a club to take out licenses for billiard tables.

He held that the definition of a club under the clause is a joint stock company, the individual members of which derive profit from the sale of liquor in connection with the operation of billiard tables, and he deposed that this could not apply to the M.A.A., as the members can derive no pecuniary benefit whatever from it, and, moreover, no liquor is allowed on the premises.

His honor took the case on deliberation.
