Borden's funeral, which occurred on Suniay, the 17th.

The testimony, however, was very clear, and on Monday, the 26th, both brothers were held for trial, charged with murder in the first degree.

Sheriff Sample, knowing his own jail to be old and insecure in case of an attack, took his prisoners to Shreveport and put them in care of Sheriff Lake.
