CHICAGO, Nov. 10.—The flood of bearish advices that have been familiar during the past month in wheat suffered some interruption, and there is a possibility that the current may run the other way shortly. Nearly all accounts agree that northwestern receipts have reached their maximum and will not taper off appreciately. It is further affirmed that supplies have been marketed so closely in certain sections of the N.W. that what remeins will prove insufficient to carry them through to another harvest. The big milling concerns at Minneapolis and Duluth are so doubtful of being able to keep their mills supplied until another harvest that they are now and have been for some days paying a premium for cash wheat over futures. It has been the cheapest article of human food; so cheap that it has even been used to a considerable extent for fattening hogs. The Michigan state report, showing but 77c of the average sown to wheat this fall, is an important proof now and suggests that other states will shortly be reporting a similar condition of short acreage.

Corn and oats—Corn advanced moderately on the strength in wheat, but realizing sales by a prominent local sperator carried the price back again to the opening figure.
