6. The duck has wings, and with these it flies high.

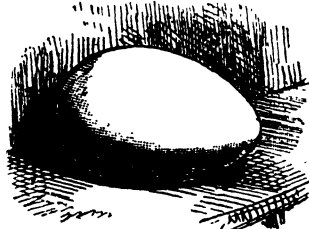
7. The duck is glad when it rains.
