

5. For planning dancing, theatrical, or musical events, the two parties will, to the extent that they are able, forward whatever information is required, with technical and advertising details, through diplomatic channels.

EXHIBITIONS

6. Expenses relating to the exchange of exhibitions will be defrayed as follows:

- (a) The sending Party's institution will cover the cost of country-to-country transportation.
- (b) The receiving Party will cover the costs of transportation within its own territory.
- (c) The receiving Party's institution will cover expenses relating to customs, set-up, organisation, security, and publicity (posters, catalogues, et cetera).
- (d) The sending Party's institution will cover all insurance costs for the exhibition. If the items exhibited should be damaged, the receiving Party must provide the sending Party with all documents relating to the damage caused, thus assisting in the making of the respective claim to the insurance company. Any costs incurred in obtaining these documents will be covered by the Party receiving the exhibition.
