

FORT LAUDERDALE - HOLLYWOOD INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

AIRPORT ASSESSMENT

Passenger enplanements for the calendar year 1991 were 3,935,746.

The Ft. Lauderdale-Hollywood International Airport had total operations of 209,752 in 1991. This includes:

- 89,666 air carrier operations
- 51,434 air taxi operations
- 67,459 general aviation operations
- 1,193 military operations

The airport recently completed a \$10 million runway extension and installation of a noise monitoring system. The airport is currently expanding its customs area and constructing an administration building. They are conducting a preliminary study for the addition of an air carrier runway. The airport expressed an interest in:

- 1) Environmental services of all types. More specifically, underground contamination, water runoff, wetlands, noise, and air quality.
- 2) Airport design companies with expertise in runway extension and terminal design.

The airport is continuously expanding and renovating and new restaurants are being added. Contract management and airport design were highlighted as areas of opportunity. Purchasing of airport equipment results from a sealed bid process. The airport suggests that manufacturers request to be placed on the mailing list for solicitation of proposals.
