| Crude Oil | - close to 100% exported to the United States |
| Natural Gas | - 100% exported to the United States |
| Electric Power | - 100% exported to the United States |
| Coal | - See table 3.2 |
| Petroleum & Coal Products | - 80 to 90 per cent exported to the United States |
| Uranium | - primarily to Japan, Western Europe, and the United States. |
