Repeal of Canada/France
Trade Agreement Act

The Secretary of State for External Affairs, the
Honourable Don Jamieson, today tabled in the House of Commons
a Bill "to repeal the Canada/France Trade Agreement Act, 1933"
which implemented the terms of the Canada/France Trade
Agreement in Canada. This action follows the decision announced
by Mr. Jamieson on December 15 that Canada was terminating
the Trade Agreement effective March 15, 1978.
