

*Proceedings on Adjournment Motion*

a number of requests from principals and guidance counsellors for information concerning its work, and because of this interest the Company has in recent weeks made available volunteer members and some former volunteers to speak about the Company of Young Canadians at various high schools. I am told that favourable comments have been received about all such speakers, including Mr. Deline. However, I am informed that Mr. Deline's name is no longer on the Company's list of available speakers.

I am sure the Company will note with interest the information which has been passed on indirectly from Kapuskasing. No doubt the Company would be glad to hear directly from people who have such information. I think the Company would want to assure the hon. member for Cochrane (Mr. Stewart) and all hon. members that if any persons are operating contrary to democratic interests and infiltrating the Company of Young Canadians, when this information is received by the Company those persons will be promptly filtered out.

Motion agreed to and the house adjourned at 10.26 p.m.
