Pro Grass Drags tear down turf at South Mountain

Over 700 people attended the Canadian Pro Grass Drag in South Mountain last Sunday to watch competitors roar down the track. The event is held every year by the Mountain Trail Blazers Snowmobile Club in conjunction with the Mountain Township Agricultural Society. There were 26 classes for various types of snowmobiles ranging from super modified to regular trail machines.
