

RESOLUTIONS *unanimously adopted at the Annual Meeting
of the Auxiliary Society for the District, held at Montreal,
on Monday Evening, May 19th, 1845. The Rev. W. M.
HARVARD in the Chair.*

was :

1. That the Report now read be adopted and printed ; and that this
Meeting gratefully rejoices in the success with which it has pleased Almighty
God to crown the efforts of the Missionaries of this and other kindred So-
cieties during the past year.

2. That this Meeting, recognizing the great principle of the Christian
Religion, that, unaided by the Holy Ghost, man's best efforts are powerless
in extending the Kingdom of our Lord Jesus Christ in the world, is resolved
to be more frequent and fervent in its supplications for the promised out-
pouring of the Spirit on Missionaries themselves, and on the fields of labour
occupied by them.

3. That this Meeting, conscious that however much may have already
been done towards the conversion of the world, much more yet remains to
be done ere "the uttermost parts of the earth can be given to the Son of
God for his possession" ; and encouraged by the numerous and pathetic
calls for additional assistance which are continually arising from various
parts of the Heathen world, solemnly pledges itself to more liberal contri-
butions, and to renewed endeavours to promote its evangelization.

4. That the cordial thanks of this Meeting be presented to all the Col-
lectors of the various Branch Societies in connection with this Auxiliary, for
their self-denying and zealous efforts to promote, during the past year, the
interests of the Parent Society.
