FRUIT MARKET LIGHTER

Raspberries Scarce and Higher — Cherries Still Plentiful and Cheap.

There was a very light market yesterday of wholesale fruits and vegetables. Raspberries were scarce and not of very good quality, selling at 10c to 14c per box. Lawton or thimble berries were scarce also, and sold at 10c to 12 1/2c per box. Cherries are still coming on in fairly large quantities and they are large fruit, but very ripe. The demand is poor, as the consumers seem to have all they want. Yesterday they sold at 60c to 65c per 11-quart basket. Cucumbers still flood the market, and there is not much demand for them, consequently the bulk is going at 15c per 11-quart basket.

WHEAT WENT UP THEN CAME DOWN

Report of Deal for Export at Montreal Excited Chicago Traders. Canadian Press Despatch. CHICAGO, Aug. 6.—On a sudden flurry, but unaccompanied by any heavy trading, the wheat market today in the December and May options ran up to the highest prices of the year. Before any extensive profit-taking could be accomplished, however, quotations had dropped back and the market closed weak at 1 1/4c to 1 3/4c advance over last night. The only basis for the brief advance appeared to be a report that some wheat had been sold here today to go to Montreal. Corn wound up 1 1/8c to 1 7/8c higher, oats with a gain of 1/4c to 1/2c and provisions at 2 1/4c to 1 1/2c advance.

MONTREAL GRAIN PRICES SOARING

Oats Particularly Strong and Active — No Change in Flour Prices. MONTREAL, Aug. 6.—A very excited feeling has developed in the local market and prices under an active demand from local and country buyers are fairly booming, the advance in oats being 2c to 3-1/2c per bushel, with sales of car lots of No. 3 Canadian western at 50c to 51c and of 100,000 bushels of No. 1, sold c.i.f. bay ports at from 48c to 47-1/2c per bushel. Manitoba barley was also strong and C. P. R. bay sales of car lots of No. 4 at 62c and of repected at 60c per bushel ex-store. Beans were very strong, with sales of 20 to 50 bag lots of three-lb. pickers at \$2.75 per bushel. There is no further change in prices for flour, but the condition of the market is strong under an active demand from the leading millers have withdrawn travelers from the road and are refusing offers from Ontario millers and stocks on spot are about exhausted, with prices for 90 cent patent quoted at 12 1/2c to 13c.

CATTLE ALL SOLD AT STOCK YARDS

Receipts of Live Stock Light and General Prices Steady to Firm.

HOG PRICES ADVANCED

Many Inferior Milk Cows Offered and Sale of These Slow.

Receipts of live stock at the Union Yards on Thursday were 29 carloads, 123 calves, 538 hogs, 613 sheep and lambs, and 44 calves. Yesterday was a clean-up of the week, and not many fresh cattle were offered. One choice lot was sold by Corbett, Hall and Coughlin at \$8.25. The rest of the cattle sold at about steady quotations. Stockers and feeders sold at \$7 to \$7.10, which was the top quotation for good choice steers. Common milkers, of which there were 123, were offered, and were very hard to dispose of, and sold at lower prices, while good choice milkers and springers were hard to sell. Veal calves, sheep and lambs, were firm, but hogs were higher as will be seen by sales below.
