Why Power Plant Failed. Lack of Field to Dispose of Its Product.

New York, July 4.—The St. Lawrence power plant at Massena, N.Y., has been sold at Massena under foreclosure proceedings begun by the first mortgage bondholders. The plant was bid in by Mark T. Cox of New York, representing the reorganization committee of the first and second mortgage bondholders for \$500,000. More than \$10,000,000 has been expended in the Massena power scheme. English capitalists were heavily interested. The failure of the project was principally due, it is believed, to a lack of field in which to dispose of the company's product.

"The costume I wear, making and all, cost \$1.25. My reform dress is so simply made that any woman can make one. My idea is that we women have one style of dress that will always be recognized as being in style, no matter how many prevailing new styles there may come in.

"I think it would be a good plan to distribute printed cards asking women who are willing to introduce the plain dress style to sign the card and wear the dress. I have thirty women already who are willing to wear the reform dress at a reception which I will give in September."

TRAFFIC ON SOO CANALS.

Tonnage This Year Has Surpassed All Previous Years.

Ottawa, July 4.—The total freight carried on the Soo Canals east and west for June was 4,721,608 tons, an increase over June, 1901, of 202,533 tons, and over June, 1900, of 614,000 tons. The total for the Canadian canal for June was 1,115,554 tons, a decrease of 116,491 tons as compared with June, 1901, but an increase of 823,000 tons as compared with June, 1900. During the season of April, May and June the total freight carried by both canals was 11,486,501 tons, an increase of 4,720,000 tons over the same period of 1901 and of 3,800,000 tons over the three months of 1900. The total trade thru Canadian canal during the three months was 3,707,732 tons, a gain of 264,000 tons over the corresponding months of 1901 and of 970,000 tons over the same quarter of 1900.

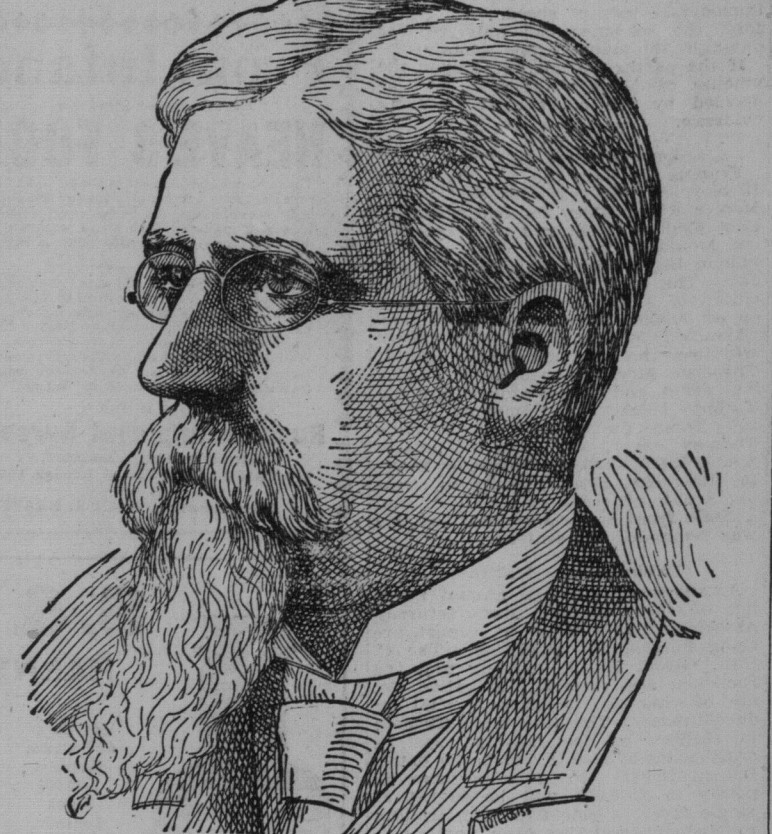
