Our Paris Letter

(From Our Own Correspondent)

Paris, France, June 10 .- No part of a woman's attire lends wearer than the supple scarf, draped with art, following every motion of the figure. At all periods feminine coquetry has been aware of this fact, and when the Directory and First Empire revived the fashions of antiquity, Josephine the manner of using the wonderful Oriental shawls brought back from Egypt by Bonaparte. She often wore them as scarfs, just as we do at present, in the evening; later they appeared larger, becoming real garments, costly marvels also, and their vogue reached its climax under the patronage of the most beautiful of our Sovereigns, Empress Eugenie. Her stately grace endowed them with a peculiar charm, and wrapping one's self became such an art that novelists of the time spoke of the question in their books. "A well-bred woman," says Balzac, the famous French author and psychologist, "has a way of her own to drape her shawl."

past, and scarfs to-day are growing so large that they recall these ancient shawls, without, however, adopting their complicated designs. 
