The Treasure.—Almansor, a rich and exalted Arabian, ate, drank, gamed, and indulged himself in every species of voluptuousness and dissipation. Once when he was tormented by that irksomeness, which is ever the follower of satiety, he was struck with the curious desire of visiting the sepulchre of his ancestors. He descended, and wandered between rows of rotting bones, not with the solemn reflection that his own must, one day, he mixed with them but with the idea of a voluptuary, that it was very cool and pleasant. Suddenly his eye was attracted by an inscription, which was half erased. It was this: "Here is hidden a greater treasure than was ever possessed by Crosus." Almansor, whose wealth was not in a small degree exhausted, had the vault immediately opened, and found—a handful of dust, under which was a marble slab, containing these words: "Ere thou deluded mortal, with daring hand profaned this vault, reigned here uninterrupted peace; a treasure which Crosus himself never possessed."
