TO RESTRICT "AMPARO"  
Mexican Legal Measure Has Been Much Abused.

Mexico City, Oct. 16.—(By mail)—Use of the "amparo" as a legal recourse in Mexico is to be restricted in a bill which the government intends to present to Congress. Abuse of the measure is the reason. President Obregon recently declared that in many instances persons arrested have already provided themselves with an "amparo" which secures their immediate release without bail. The "amparo" is one of the most generally used and at the same time the most complex procedures to be found in Mexican courts. It is a sort of injunction and writ of habeas corpus combined, and is employed either to restrain a court from acting or to secure the release of a prisoner from custody. Attorneys here admit that a real definition of the word is impossible, and point to the fact that books have been written about it, with its specific meaning and origin still obscure.

HALIFAX GIVES HEARTY WELCOME  
Basil King, Author, Regards it as Home—Guest at a Luncheon.

(Halifax Chronicle)—Basil King, noted author, who addressed the Canadian Club last night in connection with the Canadian Book Week Campaign, has received a very cordial welcome from many of his friends in the city, which he is visiting for the first time in twenty-seven years. Mr. King was the guest of honor at a very happily arranged luncheon at the Halifax Club yesterday, when he was entertained by the President and executive of the Canadian Club, the company including Mr. and Mrs. Fraser Harris, president and proposed president of the club, and a number of other prominent citizens.

Although he is living and doing his work in the United States he remained and would always remain, he said, a Canadian, and while he maintained his allegiance to the place of his birth, Charlottetown, he said that he regarded Halifax as his home. The evening he had spent here, at St. Luke's Cathedral, had been very happy, he said, and he looked upon them as the most important in his life. He was exceedingly glad, on this the first opportunity he has had to come to Halifax, to find so many of his old friends looking not only the same but better than when he left and while he noted many great improvements he was delighted to find the old things—Halifax which he loved so much still here.

Archbishop Worrell and Lieutenant Governor Grant happily voiced the feelings of the company and the community in welcoming Mr. King back and in expressing the hope that we may have the pleasure of seeing him often in the future.

THANKSGIVING SERVICES.  
The Presbyterians will have a united service on Thanksgiving Day in St. Andrews church in the morning when the minister of the church, Rev. F. S. Dowling, will conduct the service and Mr. W. H. Spencer, minister of St. Matthews church, will be the preacher. The collection will be for the Protestant Orphanage. For all members of the Methodist denomination, a united Thanksgiving service will be held on Monday in Centenary church. The service will be conducted by the pastor, Rev. R. G. 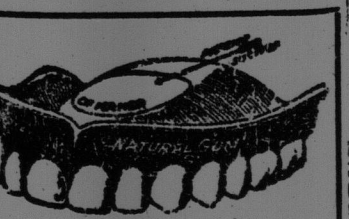
Writing in the Journal of the American Medical Association, Dr. Joseph C. Bloodgood, Professor of Clinical Surgery at Johns Hopkins Medical School, Baltimore, declares that cancer of the tongue is largely a preventable disease and that no one need be afflicted with it. He provides a list of symptoms, plain symptoms and a competent physician. To prove his point, he cites from a period between 1890 and 1921, Cancer does not start as cancer, says Dr. Bloodgood, but is something else, and it is this something else which must be detected and treated to avoid the more disastrous disease. In smokers, burn, ulcer, or other sore in the mouth, while it may be harmless in itself may very readily lead to cancer and should be treated and cured as soon as it appears. One affliction particularly dangerous is called leukoplakia. It is a white patch on the tongue or elsewhere in the mouth somewhat resembling a bit of enamel paint. It sometimes comes from excessive use of tobacco, or it may come from such an irritation as would occur in contact with a rough tooth.

"Educational propaganda," says Dr. Bloodgood, "has increased the number of operable cases from 35 to 80 per cent, and decreased the number of hopeless and inoperable cases from 47 to 20 per cent. My study of 285 lesions of the tongue in men and 38 in women convinces me that our only hope of decreased deaths from cancer depends on the educational propaganda among the public and the profession. If a man smokes and obtains good advice, he should be protected from cancer."

Speaking of the effects of tobacco, Dr. Bloodgood says that among 160 cases of tongue cancer he examined, but none were smokers of the weed. He cites the fact that rarity of cancer of the tongue in women is additional evidence that tobacco is one of the causes. Several of the women effected a cure by having used snuff by the mouth.

"When we study the histories with the idea of determining which is the most dangerous form to use tobacco, pipe, cigarette, cigar, chewing tobacco, or snuff by the mouth," says this authority, "we find numerous cases of cancer in patients who have used tobacco in only one form. Many have used it in all forms. The striking feature is the excess, not the form, the constant presence of tobacco juice in the mouth and careless smoking, so there is reported burning of some one area, producing either an area of irritation or a definite burn, or leukoplakia."

Dr. Bloodgood sums up by saying in a rough tongue:
