### **Want Federal Government To Build Wing**

eral government, in connection with reatment of invalid soldiers, build a large wing on the open space in front of the General Public Hospital and a nurses' home on the hospital lot facing White street. The idea is that these ad-ditions should be taken over at the end of the war by the municipality under ed out that by this arrangement much money would be saved to both the dominion and the municipality. The expenditure would be for a permanent building, and the needs of the hospital for additional space would be met without any duplication of expenditure.

The feeling is that a large new wing of the number of stories required, as wide as the present wing of the hospital running parallel to the nurses' home and as long as might be thought advisable—the lot is large enough for a building of any size necessary—should be constructed by the government so soon as possible, and it is pointed out that after the war when the new wing would be taken over by the hospital the government problem with respect to the care of sick sailors coming to this port would be largely solved as a result of the additional space provided for the hospital authorities. The new power house is large enough to meet the needs of such a new wing, and, in addition, the invalid soldiers would be near the provincial pathological laboratory. The ell now used as a nurses' home could be made available for the hospital staff, and the nurses would have the advantage of living in a modernly equipped home Offices would be provided in the centre of the old hospital building, where much space is now taken up by the staff and other rooms necessary in hospital work. The medical men of the city are said to be strongly in favor of this idea, as well as several members of the municipal council. It is understood that the matter will be taken at once with the federal authorities and there would seem to be good reason to expect that something will come of it.
