Allan, who is one of the representatives of New Brunswick on the Central Council and the only member of the executive from the Maritime Provinces, returned to the city on Saturday after attending the annual meeting of the society in Toronto last week and brought back encouraging reports. The New Brunswick statement was declared to be the best presented by any division and the New Brunswick plea for funds was given special consideration.
