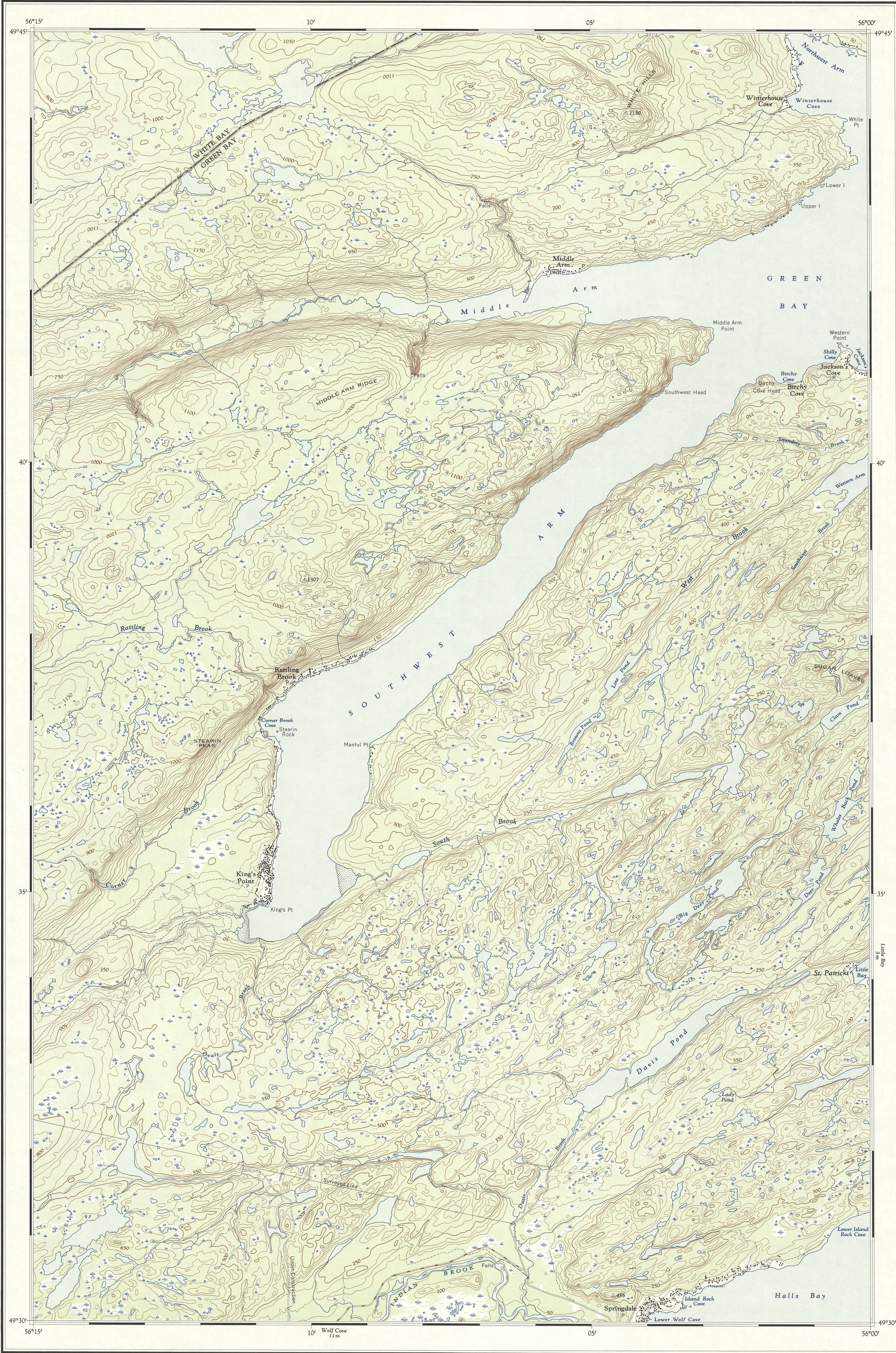


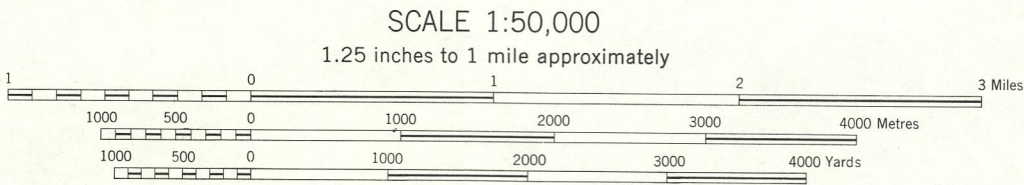

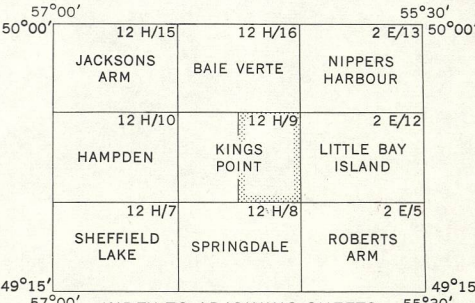


CONTOUR INTERVAL 50 FEET
