Elevations, referred to Mean sea-level, based on elevation of Mt. Albert established by the Geodetic Survey of Canada.

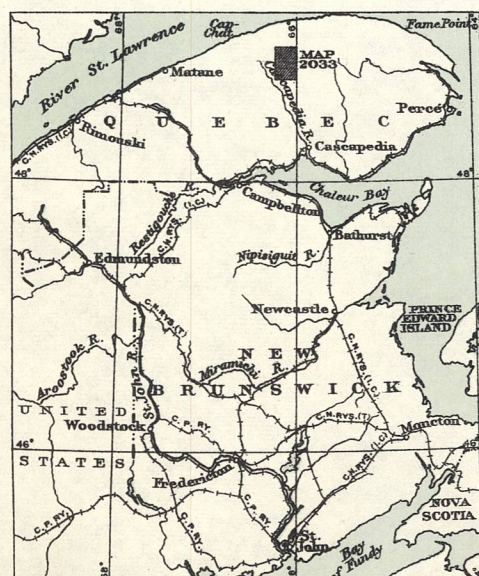

Magnetic declination, 1923.

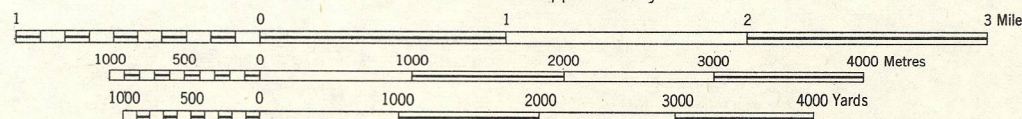
