

SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTH-WEST LAND REGULATIONS

The sole head of a family, or any male ever eighteen years of age, may homestead a quarter section of available dominion land in Manitoba, Sastathewan or Alberta. Applicant must appear in person at the dominion lands agency or sub-agency for the district. Entry by proxy may be made at any dominion lands agency (but not sub-agency), on certain conditions.

Tuties—Six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may live within nine miles of his homestead on a farm of at least eighty acres, on certain conditions. A habitable house is required except where residence is performed in the vicinity.

In certain districts a homesteader in good standing may pre-empt a quarter section alongside his homestead:

Duties—Six months' residence in such of three years after earning homestead patent; also fifty acres extra cultivation. Pre-emption patent may be obtained as soon as homestead patent, on certain conditions.
