Large number of deportations to Great Britain-Immigrants to States fewer on account of war.

Ottawa, Nov. 11.—immigration from Europe to Canada has stopped entirely. The European war is the chief cause, but another reason is the fact that immigration to Canada at the present time has been discouraged by the government.

There is some immigration from the United States and some emigration to that country also, but for the most part this is simply the coming and going of mechanics and labor men who move back and forth according to the demand for labor.

Deportations to Great Britain are unusually heavy. The general slackness of trade has caused many immigrants to become a public charge. Deportations to the enemy countries of Europe are obviously impossible at the present time, although many of these nationalities have become a charge on the public. There is some immigration from Europe to the United States, but it has fallen off less than half the usual amount.
