The Peace Treaty

Paris, Sept. 18.—The Temps today putlines what it says are the principal military and economic stipulations contained in the peace treaty which is to be presented to Bulgaria. These include abolition of obligatory military service and the maintenance of a police force which shall not exceed 20,000 men. The customs officers, gendarmes and police agents will aggregate 10,000.

Arms and munitions exceeding the quantity which Bulgaria may retain under the treaty shall be placed at points indicated by the Allies. An inter-Allied commission will supervise the execution of the military, naval and aeronautic provisions of the compact.

Bulgaria must return all valuable and the compact.
