Third s. of John Little, Esq., of Pitchcabe House, Stroud, Gloucestershire, Eng. B. in Eng. Ed. at Bedford Grammar Sch. Came to Can., 1847. M., 1854, Mary, dau. of Mr. Edward Hamil, of Tyrone, Irel. (she d. 1866). Has been a mem. of the Innisfil Council for 15 years, and of the County Council for 11 years. Is a Major South Simcoe Reserve Militia. First returned to Parlt. at last g. e. for present seat. A Conservative, and a supporter of Sir J. A. Macdonald.—*Allendale, Ont.*

MACDONALD, ANGUS PETER. (*West Middlesex.*)

A contractor. Sat for West Middlesex, in L.A., Can., from g. e., 1857 to g. e. 1861, when defeated. Returned to Commons at last g. e. A Conservative, and a supporter of Sir J. A. Macdonald.—*Glencoe, Ont.*

MACDONALD, Lieut.-Col. DONALD ALEXANDER. (*Glengarry.*)

B. in Upper Canada. Is a younger brother of the Hon. John S. Macdonald. M. a dau. of the late Col. Fraser. A merchant. Was a contractor on the G. T. Railway, and built the aqueduct for the Water Works of Montreal. Has been Warden of Stormont, Dundas and Glengarry. Is Lieut.-Col. commanding the Glengarry Reserve Militia, and a director of the Ontario Bank. Sat for present seat in L. A., Can., from g. e., 1857, until the Union. Elected to Commons by acclamation at last g. e. *Alexandria, Ont.; Rideau Club.*
