

An Act to amend the Unorganized Territories' Game Preservation Act, 1894.

HER Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

1 Section 4 of *The Unorganized Territories' Game Preservation Act*, 1894, chapter 31 of the statutes of that year, is hereby amended by striking out the figures "1900" at the end of the section, and by inserting the figures "1902" in lieu thereof; and also by adding the following subsection thereto:—

10 "2. On and after the said date male buffalo and bison may be killed or taken under permit to be granted under the following provisions of this Act; but the female shall remain protected, and shall not be hunted, taken, killed, shot at, wounded, injured or molested in any way."

15 "2. Section 21 of the said Act is hereby amended by adding the following subsection thereto:—

"3. On and after the first day of January, 1902, the holder of a permit issued under the provisions of this section may kill for scientific purposes, or may take with a view to domestication, one male buffalo or male bison, but no more."
